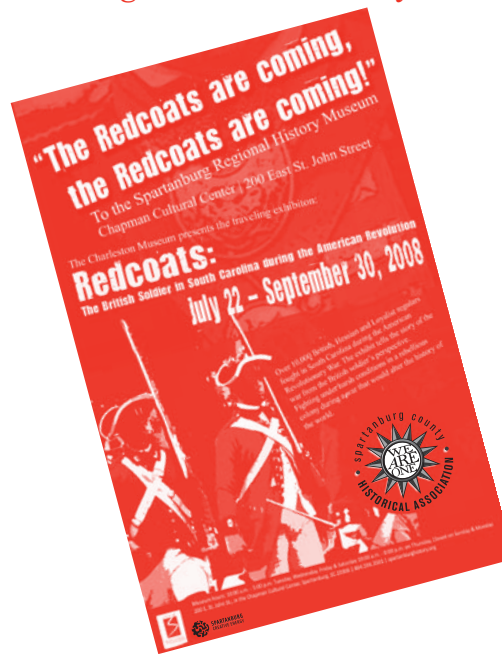

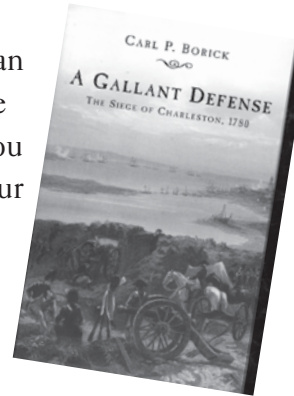
## Symposium Reception
