UNIFORM & EQUIPMENT

GUIDELINES

UNIFORMS

- 1) Shirt - flannel, mustard color
- 2) Trousers - wool, mustard color
- 3) Undershirt - OD or white cotton, athletic or crew style
- 4) Waist Belt - M1937 Web w/open faced buckle
- 5) Shoes, Service - roughout or captoe
- 6) Leggings, canvas - M1938, pea green or khaki color
- 7) Jacket, Field - M41
- 8) Helmet - M1 w/Liner

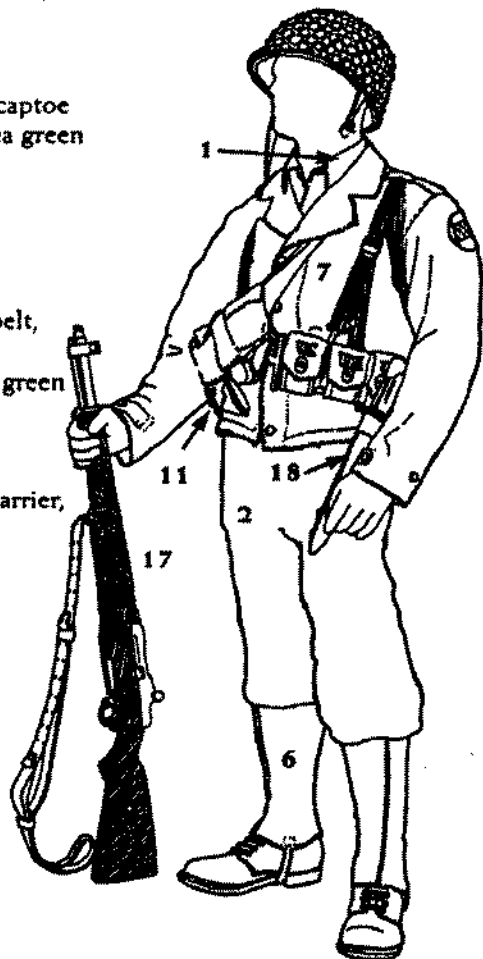
EQUIPMENT

- 9) Cartridge Belt - M1923 web belt, pea green or khaki color
- 10) Canteen Cover - M1910, pea green or khaki color
- 11) First Aid Pouch - M1942, pea green or khaki color
- 12) Haversack - M1928, w/pack carrier, pea green or khaki color
- 13) Canteen & Cup - M1910
- 14) Meat Can - M1942 w/utensils
- 15) Shovel - M1910 or M1943 w/cover
- 16) Blanket - wool WWII

WEAPONS

- 17) Rifle - M1 Garand w/sling and blank adapter
- 18) Bayonet - M1905 or M1

The above list is intended as a general guide to the basic uniform and equipment that the average combat infantryman would have worn in Northwest Europe in 1944-45. It is recommended not only for historical accuracy but also because it will be acceptable at almost any event. Members are always free to expand beyond this basic impression and wear any uniform or equipment appropriate for particular historical simulations or displays.
